

Mory's Dress Code Proposal

The new dress code at Mory's is based upon the current trend towards more casual attire. However, many of our members and their guests are from the local business community and Yale faculty and often come for lunch and dinner dressed in jacket and tie. It is important therefore that members observe the spirit of the dress code.

Dining Room – Lunch & Dinner

Our preferred dress code is Business Casual.

For men this includes:

Blazers or sports jackets (optional), collared shirts, turtlenecks, sweaters, cardigans, tailored trousers, khakis, corduroys. Dress jeans are also acceptable.

For women this includes:

Collared shirts or blouses with sleeves, turtlenecks, sweaters, dresses, skirts, tailored pants, khakis, corduroys. Dress jeans are also acceptable.

Baseball caps and other headgear should not be worn in the dining room. Tee shirts, flip flops, and beach sandals are also not appropriate.

Temple Bar

The dress code in Temple Bar is more relaxed than the dining room. Athletic attire and tee shirts are permissible. Torn clothing and attire with offensive language are not appropriate.
